The student leaders are organising a FREAKY FRIDAY this week - 14 May. This means that children can wear funny hairstyles, clothing etc.

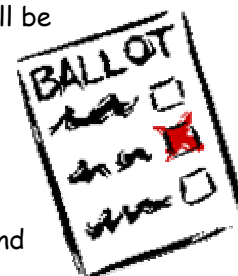
Congratulations to these people who graduated last week
