We hope you have enjoyed some time with your whānau over the holidays and are well rested for a busy term.

In Term 3 the school wide Topic focus is on Visual Art. Each class has chosen a different aspect of this topic and will be creating pieces of art which will be displayed in classrooms for our Whānau Open Afternoon in week 9.

### **Mathematics**

We have started this term with 2 weeks of Geometry. Tamariki are learning about the properties of 2 and 3 dimensional shapes and to communicate the results of translations, reflections and rotations on plane shapes.

In week 3 we will move back to Number with a focus on Addition and Subtraction followed by Multiplication and Division.

### **Health and P.E.**

This term's focus is on gymnastics. On Tuesday afternoons the Takahē students will be participating in a range of gymnastics activities including, jumping, rolling and balancing.
