In Term 3 the school wide Topic focus is on Visual Art, with a particular focus on Ngāi tipu Ngāi kīrehe - Flora and Fauna. Each class has chosen a different aspect of this topic and will be creating pieces of art which will be displayed in classrooms for our Whānau Open Afternoon in week 9 (23 September).

Mathematics

Our maths strand focus for this term is Geometry and Measurement. Tamariki are learning about measuring length, area, volume, capacity, weight, angles, temperature and time. Our Number focus is Addition and Subtraction followed by Multiplication and Division.

Health and P.E.

With the weather in Term 3 being particularly unsettled this term's focus is on Jump Jam. On Wednesday afternoons Tui students will be learning a range of Jump Jam routines. There are also a range of interschool sports for our students to participate in including: hockey, gymnastics, tackle rugby and netball.
