8th May Minutes

Minutes: Janet said she had missed one item in the minutes which was the launch of the Friends of Waikumete book on 1st June... The WRLB has agreed to fund the Welcome pack developed by Jade Tang-Taylor.

What's on: The Housing Call to Action (HC2A) is being held at Ceramco Function Centre on Friday 31st May from 9 30am -2 30pm. It is an extension of last year's session to progress matters.

Glen Eden Residents' group meeting is Saturday 11th May at 9 30am at the Community House. Manson's hope to have a representative attend.

Sandra reported that Vision West food bank hours are changing to Mon, Wed and Fridays from 12-2pm. Isaiah hopes they will join the food bank group because networking is helpful and more efficient by sharing information.

Claire noted that Sport Waitakere is working on programmes for Parrs Park and Glenora, involving sport and hip hop. The Arts team will be arranging a Matariki event in June. It will be outdoors in the town centre and will have the choir from Hoani Waititi Kura present.

Gary reported that the Baptist Church holds fortnightly community meals (Wednesdays) in the on-site café where there is often food to be taken home in packs. They are catering for 75-100 people. They are mainly homeless and needy. The church family helps out and Vision West works with them as well. Gary has provided information to Jade for inclusion in the Welcome pack. It was a timely linking of Gary with Isaiah re food bank network information.

Isaiah mentioned that there would be a new Methodist minister appointed at the end of the year.

GE Goes Gold: Kay is making progress with the programme. There will be a ukulele group playing at lunchtime, information stalls and catering for 70, with finger food: pizzas, sandwiches and cakes.

Isaiah suggested there should be an election meeting for candidates in the local body elections again this year. Perhaps it could be done in conjunction with the BID at the RSA as it was 3 years ago.
