Curriculum Focus

We hope you have enjoyed some time with your whānau and are well rested for a busy term. In Term 2 the school wide Topic focus is on the many and varied aspects of Science. Each class will choose different aspects of this topic with lots of hands-on activities.

Mathematics

Statistics is an area we will focus on this term where tamariki will learn through statistical investigations, where they gather, sort and display data. Number learning will continue with a focus on Multiplication and then Fractions

Health & PE Focus

This term we are working on large ball skills. The skills practiced during class PE lessons will be applied to games during Tui Sport. This term we will have students representing GEPS at a range of Inter-school sports including Cross Country, Rugby League, Rippa Rugby and Tackle Rugby.

In week 3 and week 4, tamariki will be taking part in the **Keeping Ourselves Safe** programme "**Knowing What to Do - Me Mōhio Kia Pēhea**" This will be taught by your child's teacher, with help from the local Police Education Officer.

Knowledge-a-thon

This term we are having a knowledge -a-thon fundraiser. The Year 5 & 6 students will have 40 questions to practice. Testing sheets will come home later in the term.
