Thanks to everyone who came to the whānau evening last week. It was great to see so many of you at school. One of the main messages of the evening was about how we have moved to Seesaw across the school. Please see your child's class teacher to be able to log in. Over the year your child's learning will be posted here as well as notices and reminders about school events.

This year we have introduced two new trophies for assembly - taiao (environment) and kairangi (striving to be the best). 


