Each week our tamariki also get music lessons with Mrs Chettiar. Our senior choir is also run by Mrs Chettiar and they are already sounding amazing. We are so very lucky to have such talented kaiako who can give our students lots of quality experiences.

A reminder that breakfast is available every morning in the wharekai. We have weetbix, yoghurt and fruit each day and we will be doing some hot breakfasts as we move into autumn. You are more than welcome to bring the whole family in to enjoy a kai together. We also have kai baskets in every class that students can help themselves to. They have fruit pottles, scroggin mixes and muesli bars. Lunch with Crunch continues to provide daily lunches for our tamariki. 


