Nau mai, haere mai Welcome to Term 1

Topic Focus

Our topic this term is largely based on whakawhanaungatanga (building relationships and connections). This will be built on through the learning of our new school pepeha as well as our individual pepeha. A pepeha is a way of introducing yourself in tereo M_a ori as well as connecting you to places and people. It is also a wonderful way for students to celebrate and share their cultural identities. A new year also comes with everyone having a shared understanding of our school values: whakawhanaungatanga, kairangi, ako and manaakitanga.

Health PE Focus

The main PE focus for this term is swimming. Our pool is a wonderful resource for students to develop water confidence and safety, as well as their swimming skills. Each Takah $_{\bar{e}}$ class swims three times a week, with an optional lunchtime wh $_{\bar{a}}$ nau swim on Tuesday and Thursday. Children are expected to participate in the class swimming sessions. Students also have weekly P.E. sessions with Mr Shouaib. It is essential that children have a water bottle, shoes and sun hat for these sessions.

General Reminder

It is extremely important for students to wear sun hats and to have water bottles on hand everyday. Classes have sunscreen which students are encouraged to use.

Takah**ē** Team

- Takahē Team consists of four Year 3 & 4 composite classes Room 1, Room 5, Room 11 and Room 15, and one Year 2 & 3 composite class Room 9.
- **Belongings** We actively encourage tamariki to take responsibility for their own belongings. Names in hats, swimming togs, towels, clothes and scooters make it easier to return any misplaced items. Teachers have vivid markers that you are welcome to borrow to name these items.
- **Reading -** Books read with the teacher or buzz box books may be sent home for further practice. Some students have a reading eggs account which can be used both at home and at school. Logons and passwords will be glued into homework books. All students need a book bag to transport readers and library books between home and school. They can reuse last year's one or buy one from the office for **\$6**.
- Mathematics In mathematics we have started the year with 3 weeks of Statistics. Tamariki are learning to investigate, group, graph and comment on sets of data. In week 4 we will move onto Addition and Subtraction. Learning the addition and subtraction basic facts will help tamariki to progress. Basic facts relevant to the topic will be glued into homework books for extra practice.
- **Communication with whānau** Communication with whā nau will be through our school newsletter that is emailed and also found on our website. We also share information through our new student management system 'Hero' and Facebook.
- Trip Our term 1 trip is to our local stream, Waikumete, where we will take part in water testing, a stream clean up, mulching stream edge areas and potting native plants. More information to come.
- Meet the Teacher This year we are holding an open afternoon on Wednesday 26th February from 2:00-3:00 pm. You will be able to meet your child's teacher, have a look around the classroom and ask questions.
